# About 365 Suido (Earthquake-Resistant Antifreeze Water Station)

365 Suido (earthquake-resistant antifreeze water station) was introduced in 2024 to commemorate the 90th anniversary of Morioka City waterworks, as part of the city's disaster preparedness efforts. It serves as a public drinking fountain, providing access to Morioka's tap water.

Designed to function even in the event of earthquakes or other disasters, it ensures a continuous water supply **24 hours a day, 365 days a year**. Also, its antifreeze construction makes it reliable even in cold climates like Morioka.

### **Key Features**

#### 1. Earthquake Resistant

Made with pipes constructed to resist seismic activity, ensuring safe water access even during disasters.

#### 2. Frost Resistant


Designed to resist freezing, providing a stable water supply even in harsh winter conditions.

#### 3. Impact Resistant

Protected by a concrete casing, making it highly durable and resistant to damage.

#### 4. Operates During Power Outages

Functions without electricity, ensuring access to water even during blackouts.



# **Installed Locations**

365 Suido (earthquake-resistant antifreeze water station) will be installed at evacuation sites, such as elementary and junior high schools.
